All felines will receive services prior to temporary placement in your home. Services include: spay/neuter, rabies vaccine, FVCRP vaccine(s), dewormer, flea/tick preventative and each one will be tested for Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) and Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV).

All you need to do is provide food, water a litter box and lots of love and attention! Foster care animals need to remain indoors.

Sometimes this work can be challenging depending on the history of the animal. Many have been living on the streets. But, they all deserve a loving home. Some animal experience is necessary and we will provide further instructions and socialization tips. The more fosters we have, the more animals we can help.

There is an overpopulation epidemic. Thousands of cats and kittens are brought to area shelters each year. Responsible pet ownership education and low-cost spay and neuter for pets will help, but the way we make a difference is in the lives of folks who adopt these wonderful animals.
